#### Rules for Exhibitors

1. The show is open to every member of the public.
2. The Exhibitor may enter no more than two exhibits in any Class, **except** in Cut Flower Section, where only one entry is allowed per Class.
3. The Exhibitor must have grown exhibit for at least three months prior to the date of the Show. This regulation does not apply to floral and other designs where purchased flowers may form part of the arrangement; however the actual design **MUST** be the creation of the Exhibitor.
4. Registration is free. Please contact the Montserrat National Trust at 491-3086 for Tickets for the Tea Party.
5. All potted plants must be received by **5 pm on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> March.**
6. All Floral Designs and Cut Flower entries must be received by 8:30am on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> March.
7. Exhibits must not be removed before the last day of the Exhibition and must be removed by Friday, March 18th. Entries could be freshened after the Judging is completed.
8. All entries must be in accordance with the Show's Rules and Classifications.
9. All entries must be properly tagged, using the exhibit tags provided by the Committee and properly registered by an Official of the Botanic Garden Flower Show Committee. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to ensure that the entries are correctly labeled.
10. The tags must be attached to the specimen and not to the display container or stand.
11. Judging of the entries will take place on Monday, March 14<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:30am.
12. No Exhibitor should be present during the judging of his or her exhibit. The judges' decision is final.
13. The Committee will exercise all care, but will not be responsible for loss or breakage of entries and containers or accessories.
14. Forms will be available for registering for the Flower Show. These can be obtained from the Montserrat National Trust or Committee Members.
15. Completed Registration Forms must reach the Trust by Friday, March 4, 2016.

## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

### SECTION 1 – CUT FLOWERS

#### Class

(Only one entry in Classes 1 to 9, refer to Rule 2)

- 1      **ANNUAL** – eg Gerbera, Cockscomb/Celosia, Zinnia (single specimen)
- 2      **ANTHURIUM** - hybrid (single stem displayed without foliage)
- 3      **GINGER FAMILY** – **red, pink or white** (single specimen displayed with maximum two leaves)
- 4      **IXORA** – **miniature, medium or large** (single specimen)
- 5      **ROSE - hybrid tea, any colour** (single specimen bloom)
- 6      **ROSE** – **Floribunda, any colour** (single spray)
- 7      **ORCHID** (single flowering stem, displayed without foliage or artificial aids)
- 8      **BANANA FAMILY** – **Heliconia, any colour** (single specimen)
- 9      **OTHER CUT FLOWER**, not specified above, in classes 1 to 8 (single specimen)



## **SECTION 2 - POTTED PLANTS**

### **DIVISION 2A      FLOWERING PLANTS (single plant)**

#### **Class**

- 10     Anthurium
- 11     Bougainvillea
- 12     Episcia
- 13     Bromeliad
- 14     Euphorbia milii (Crown of Thorns)
- 15     Adenium (Desert Rose)
- 16     Orchid - Dendrobium group
- 17     Orchid - Phalaenopsis
- 18     Orchid - Oncidium
- 19     Other Orchid, not specified in classes 16 to 18, eg Cattleya, Vanda
- 20     Other Flowering plant, not specified above in classes 10 to 15

### **DIVISION 2B      FOLIAGE PLANTS**

#### **Class**

- 21     Aglaonema
- 22     Dieffenbachia (single or multiple stemmed)
- 23     Aralia
- 24     Dracaena
- 25     Philodendron, self heading or climbing
- 26     Syngonium



- 27 Fern – Adiantum (Maiden Hair)
- 28 Fern – Nephrolepis
- 29 Fern – Other not specified, in classes 27 to 28
- 30 Croton
- 31 **Palm**
- 32 **Other Foliage Plant** - not specified in Division 2B, classes 21 to 31 (plant is less than 18 inches in height, not including pot)
- 33 **Other Foliage Plant** - not specified in Division 2B, classes 21 to 31 (plant is more than 18 inches in height, not including pot)
- 34 **Cacti – column type** (hairy/non-hairy), eg. **mammillaria, other**
- 35 **Sansevieria** (mother-in-law tongue)
- 36 **Other Succulent** (agave, aloe, crassula, echeveria, kalanchoe)
- 37 **Collection of cacti and/or succulent** (at least three plants)

#### **DIVISION 2C CREATIVE POTTED PLANT EXHIBIT**

- 38 A flowering or foliage plant (other than Orchid, Cacti or Succulent) grown in an unusual container – not exceeding 18” in height and 18” in width - for tabletop display



## **SECTION 3 – FLORAL ART or FLOWER ARRANGEMENT**

*(local material may be grown by exhibitor or purchased)*

### **DIVISION 3A      FLORAL ARRANGEMENT (FRESH MATERIAL)**

- 39      An arrangement using local plant material only
- 40      An arrangement using foliage only
- 41      An interpretative arrangement of the theme “*Montserrat, Naturally Beautiful*”, using local and/or imported plant material (Accessories may be used also)

### **DIVISION 3B      FLORAL ARRANGEMENT (DRIED MATERIAL)**

- 42      An arrangement using local and/or imported plant material only

### **DIVISION 3C      ARTISTIC CREATION**

- 43      An arrangement made from plant material other than flowers or foliage (green leaves) – eg stumps, roots, barks, dried leaves, string etc (No accessories allowed)

## **SECTION 4 –FRUITS, VEGETABLES AND HERBS**

*(All exhibits in this Section must be grown locally)*

### **DIVISION 4A      LOCALLY GROWN FRUITS**

- 44      Collection of three or four distinct kinds of fruits (displayed in container, not exceeding 12” in diameter or 12” square and arranged for effect)
- 45      Jumbo/Giant size fruit (single specimen)

### **DIVISION 4B      LOCALLY GROWN VEGETABLES**

- 46      A basket sized 6” to 12” of three or more vegetables (arranged for effect)
- 47      Jumbo/Giant size vegetable (single specimen)

### **DIVISION 4C      LOCALLY GROWN HERBS**

- 48      Herb in a container (single specimen)
- 49      Basket of three (3) or four (4) Herbs, attractively arranged for effect

## **SECTION 5 – FLORAL AND CREATIVE ART**

*(Exhibits made by children, age fifteen and under)*

- 50 miniature floral arrangement (not to exceed 5 inches in both height and diameter)
- 51 petite floral arrangement (not to exceed 9 inches in both height and diameter)
- 52 artwork or creative art of plant/flower
